CONFESSION AND FORGIVENESS

Therefore, brothers and sisters in Christ, let us confess our sins and failures before the Lord, because He is risen, and He promises to forgive us!

silent reflection and confession

- C Lord God, the empty tomb shows your immense power and greatness. By contrast, we are weak and powerless, and our hearts go astray so easily. We have repeatedly fallen into temptation and disobeyed your commands. Fill us with the power of your resurrection! Forgive us our failures. Help us to live a new life for you, and on the last day, raise us up to live forever with you. Amen.
- "Jesus Christ, who is the firstborn from the dead... loves us and has freed us from our sins by his blood." (Revelation 1:4-5) Christ is risen! We are weak, but he is strong! After Jesus had risen from the dead, he commanded his disciples to preach repentance and forgiveness of sins in his name to all nations (Luke 24:47). Through Jesus Christ, risen from the dead, we have forgiveness for our wrongdoing, peace with God and power from the Holy Spirit to change our lives. Christ is risen!





CONFESSION OF FAITH

The Nicene Creed




PRAYER OF THE CHURCH


P Let us pray for the whole people of God in Christ Jesus and for all people according to their needs.

O Gracious Father, help us believe that because Jesus lives, we, too, are made alive by faith and shall live with Him eternally.


- **G** Risen Lord, live in us that we may live in You.


RECEPTION OF THE LORD'S SUPPER




