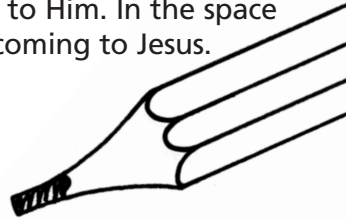
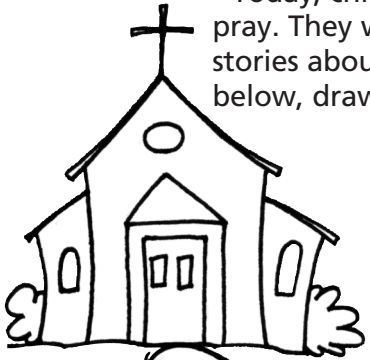


# SOMETHING to DRAW

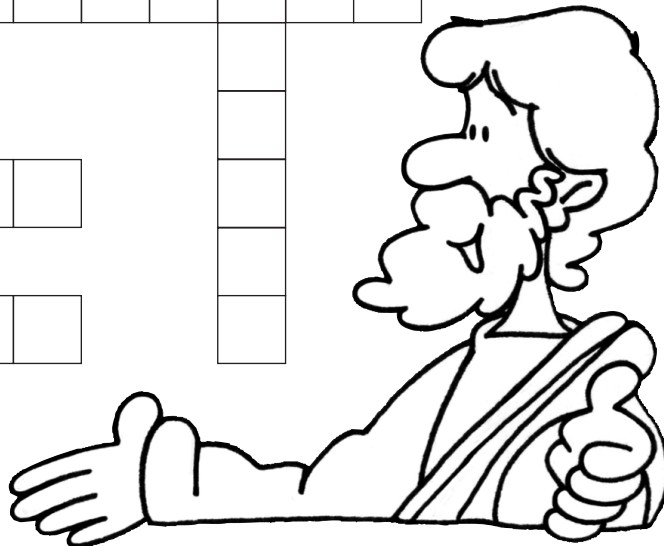
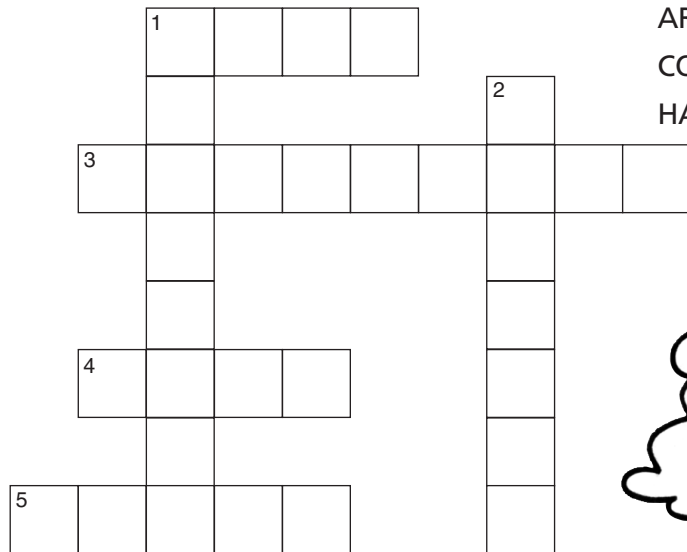
**CROSSWORD PUZZLE**
