Try to fit Jesus' words from today's Gospel into the squares below. One word has been done for you.

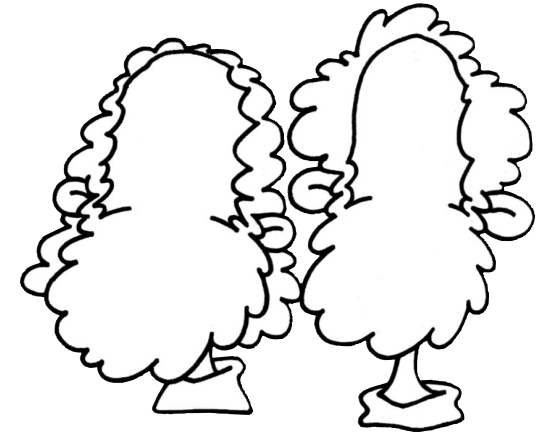
