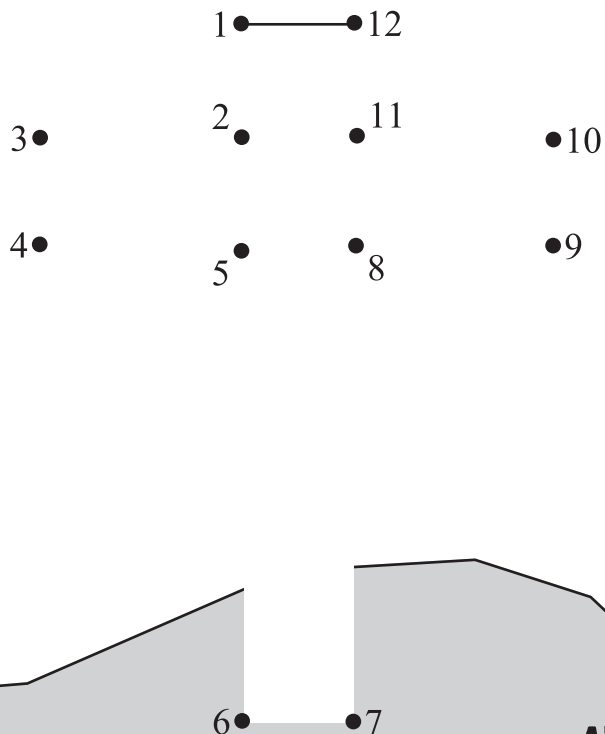


## DOT to DOT

Good Friday did not seem good then. But now we know it was. Because of what Jesus did, we can be God's children forever. Connect the dots to see something that helps us remember Good Friday.

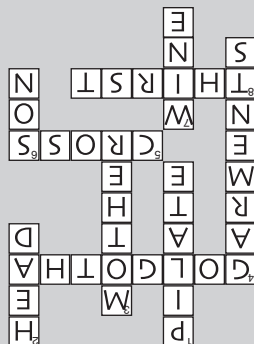

John 19:17–18

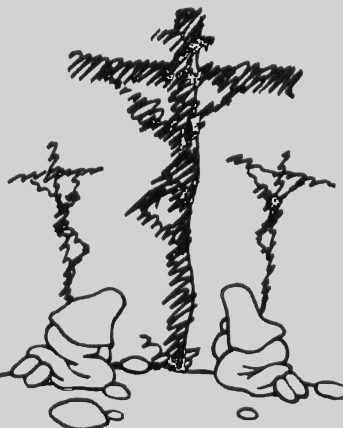
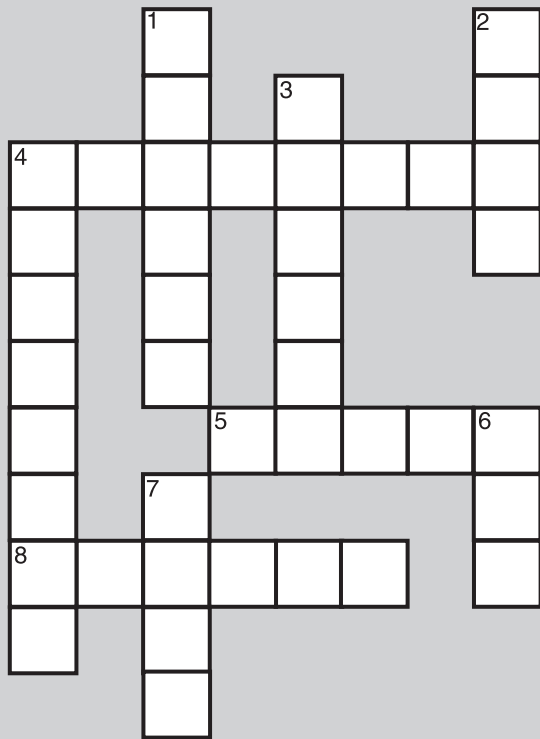
